

### What funds can I use to purchase Espresso?

<b>Title I</b>  Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged	The purpose of this program is to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging State academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.  <a href="#">Read more about Title I funding</a>	Espresso is a standards-aligned digital curriculum service that can help provide remediation and enrichment in all subject areas, but especially in reading, language arts, and mathematics. The service provides opportunities to address all multiple intelligences and is an excellent resource in a differentiated classroom. The service can be utilized by parents, tutors and educational professionals.
<b>Individuals with Disabilities Education Act</b>  Part B: Ages 3-21	This program highlights that special education and related services should be designed to meet the unique learning needs of eligible children with disabilities. The program connects with ideas for the multiple intelligences, differentiated instruction, and technology enhanced curriculum.
<b>Title II, Part A</b>  Improving Teacher Quality State Grants	The purpose of this program is to increase academic achievement by improving teacher and principal quality. The term "high-quality professional development" means professional development that meets the criteria contained in the definition of professional development in <i>Title IX</i> , Section 9101(34) of ESEA.  <a href="#">Find out more about Title II, Part A funding</a>	This grant supports the provision of Espresso's professional development either online, face-to-face, or as a hybrid approach. This grant can be used to supplement other funds used to purchase the service itself.

<p><b>Title II, Part D</b></p> <p>Enhancing Education through Technology</p>	<p>The primary goal of this program is to improve student achievement through the use of technology in schools, including helping all students become technologically literate and through the integration of technology with curriculum development.</p> <p><a href="#">Find out more about EETT funding</a></p>	<p>Espresso is a digital curriculum service that allows educators to effectively integrate standards-based academic content into curriculum and instruction. The technological assets provide content applications for enrichment and remediation across subject areas. Additionally, high quality professional development provides for the demonstration of teacher understanding of student learning styles, best practices in instruction, and technology integration strategies to maximize student learning.</p>
<p><b>Head Start</b></p>	<p>Head Start promotes school readiness by enhancing the social and cognitive development of children through the provision of educational, health, nutritional, social and other services. Emphasis is placed on parental involvement. Head Start engages parents in their children's learning and helps them in making progress toward their educational, literacy and employment goals.</p> <p><a href="#">Find out more about Head Start</a></p>	<p>With an excellent collection of resources developed specifically for Pre-K to 3, Espresso supports Head Start programs in achieving their goals.
